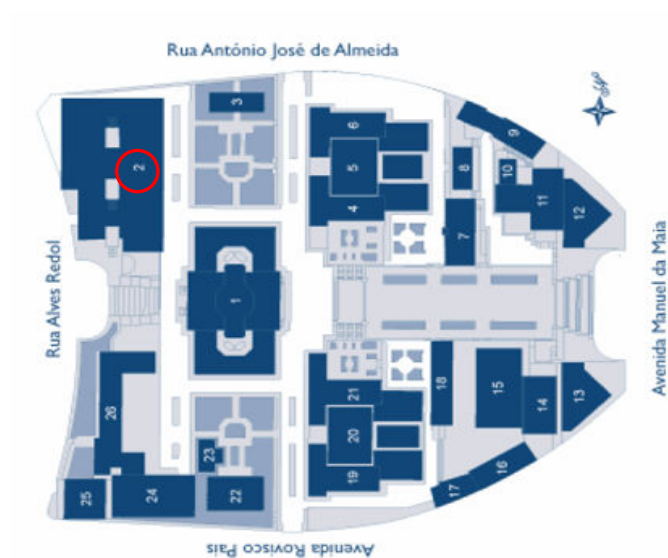

##### Alameda Campus

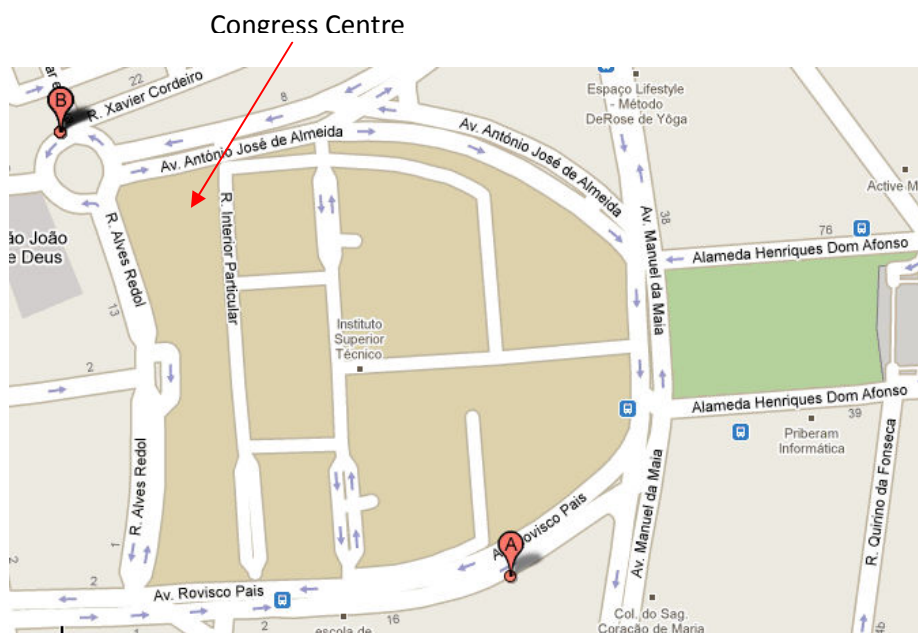

## How to get here



### Airport

The Alameda campus is 10 minutes away from the Lisbon Airport (Portela). You have different alternatives to get to the city centre, from the common city bus (provided by Carris) to the practical taxi.



### Taxi

Taxis allow you to arrive in IST from any point in the city, but of course the fare also increases according to the distance, traffic and day time. An airport-IST trip is around 10 euros.



### Metro

There is not yet a metropolitan connection between the airport and the city centre. However, the Metro can be useful for tour visits around Lisbon, as it is the fastest way to get to most of the interesting places in Lisbon.

The closest metropolitan stations from the IST Alameda campus are:

- “**Saldanha**” station: Yellow Line and Red Line
- “**Alameda**” station: Green Line and Red Line

- Av. Rovisco Pais: 16, 22, 40, 718, 720 e 767
- Alameda: 7, 22, 40, 718, 720 e 767
- Saldanha: 16, 36, 44, 83, 718, 726, 727
